- 2. Are there people in your life who seem to be "non-committal" to the gospel? How do you respond to that?

Acts 17:16-19, 29-34 - Paul's debates in Athens, Greece with the philosophers

- 1. Describe the scenario of Paul "reasoning" with these philosophers. How would you have this type of discussion with co-workers today?
- 2. What was the variety of responses Paul experienced(vs 32-34)?
- 3. What evidence was there that the Holy Spirit was at work with some of those there?
- 4. How can this study help you in witnessing to your friends or neighbors.....or skeptics?
