- 3. Considering the boat represents safety, what does it mean for you to get out of the boat?
- 4. Matt. 9:2, 22, and Mark 10:46-52 all speak of courage related to someone's faith. How might courage work alongside faith in your life?
- 5. The storm didn't stop until Peter was back in the boat. What are the ways you can live with faith in the midst of your storm?
