- 3. Describe "provoke" or "embitter" in vs 21. If you have children or if you've been provoked as a child, would you be open to discuss your experience here?
- Pick one to answer:
 - *How did you move through (respond) the experience of being provoked (as a child)?
 - *How did you move through (respond) the experience of Provoking (fathers)? Was your response a healthy and biblical one?
